Cuba is a poor country, but every child, from the day they are born until the day they die, will have free health care, at every level. They don't even pay for medicine. Cuba is a poor country, but if you were a student in Cuba, you wouldn't pay a penny for education, not a penny. When you look at poor Cuba, and its concern for its citizens, and when you look at America, rich America and its homeless, of which Cuba has none. You can see the difference between capitalism and socialism."
